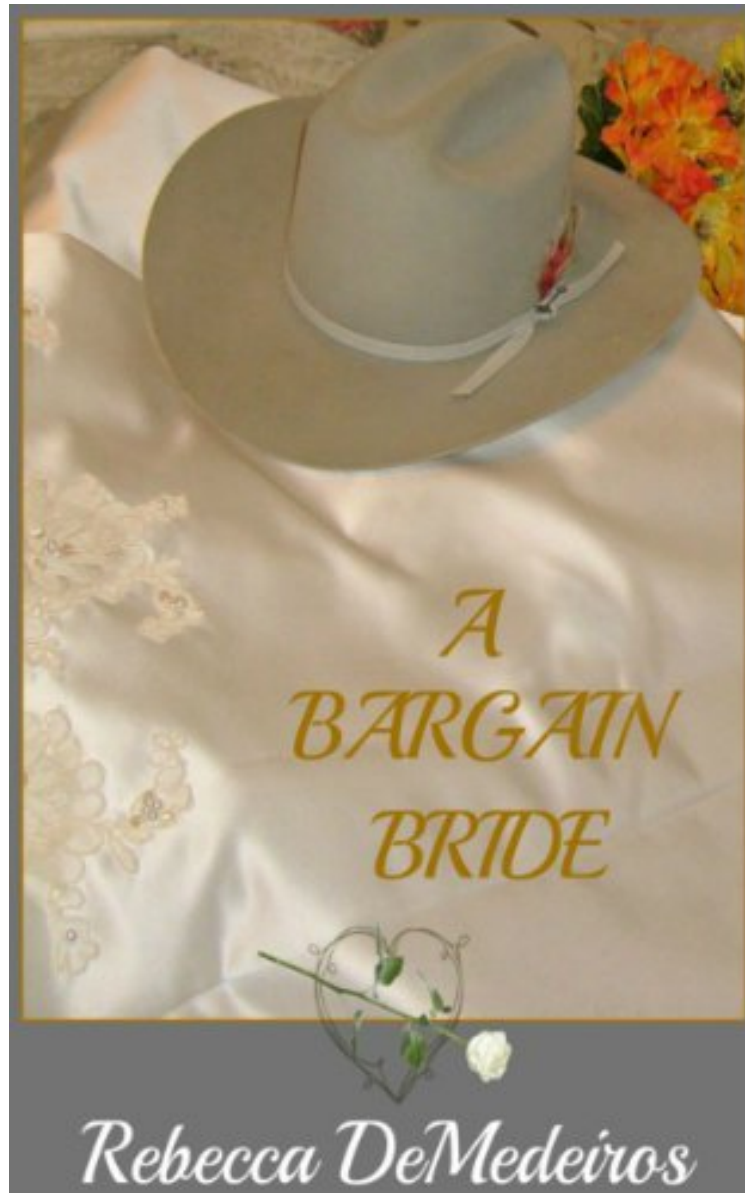

Als Melody Gabriel kennenlernt, beginnt es schon bald zwischen den beiden zu knistern, sodass sich Gabriel nun doch auf die Ehe freut. Was niemand ahnt, ist, dass eine perverse Bestie es auf die junge Frau und ihre Schwester abgesehen hat, die alles zu zerstören droht. "A Bargain Bride" von Rebecca De Medeiros ist ein ansprechend geschriebenes Buch mit sympathischen Haupt- und Nebenprotagonisten, die charakterlich ziemlich gut entwickelt sind. Ich möchte jeden einzelnen von ihnen, allen voran Lily, die mir von ihrem ersten Auftritt an ans Herz gewachsen ist. Mathew, Michael und Pops sowie die Hauptfiguren Gabriel und Melody möchte ich ebenso gerne und freue mich besonders, dass es ein Wiedersehen mit ihnen in den weiteren Bänden der Buchreihe gibt. Was mir in Liebesgeschichten generell nicht gefällt, sind eingebaute Krimis, weil diese oft aufgesetzt wirken, um uninteressanten Geschichte ein bisschen Spannung zu verleihen. Autoren und Autorinnen wie Mary Balogh zeigen, dass man durchaus eine schöne und interessante Lovestory schreiben kann, ohne diese mit einem Krimiplot "aufzuwerten" oder spannender zu machen. Bei diesem Buch ist der Krimiteil jedoch sehr gut ausgearbeitet. Für einige Leser/innen romantischer Liebesgeschichten mag ein pedophiler Jäger, dessen Taten zwar nicht sehr detailreich, aber doch auf mehreren Seiten beschrieben werden, abschreckend wirken, daher mein Hinweis darauf. Gewürzt ist das Buch mit einer Prise Humor, sodass man beim Lesen immer wieder ins Schmunzeln und Lachen gerät. Einige Sexszenen zwischen dem Ehepaar kommen auch vor, die geschmackvoll beschrieben werden. Alles in allem ist dieser erste Teil der "Brides of Liberty"-Reihe ein gut geschriebenes Buch für einige nette Lesestunden.
