Die Protagonistin wird von sadistischen Writern im Vorraum zu den Gefängniszellen einen Tag lang angekettet, so dass sie unvermeidbar mithören muss, wie die Writter über das Sicherheitssystem der Rebellen sprechen und wie man es austrickst.
