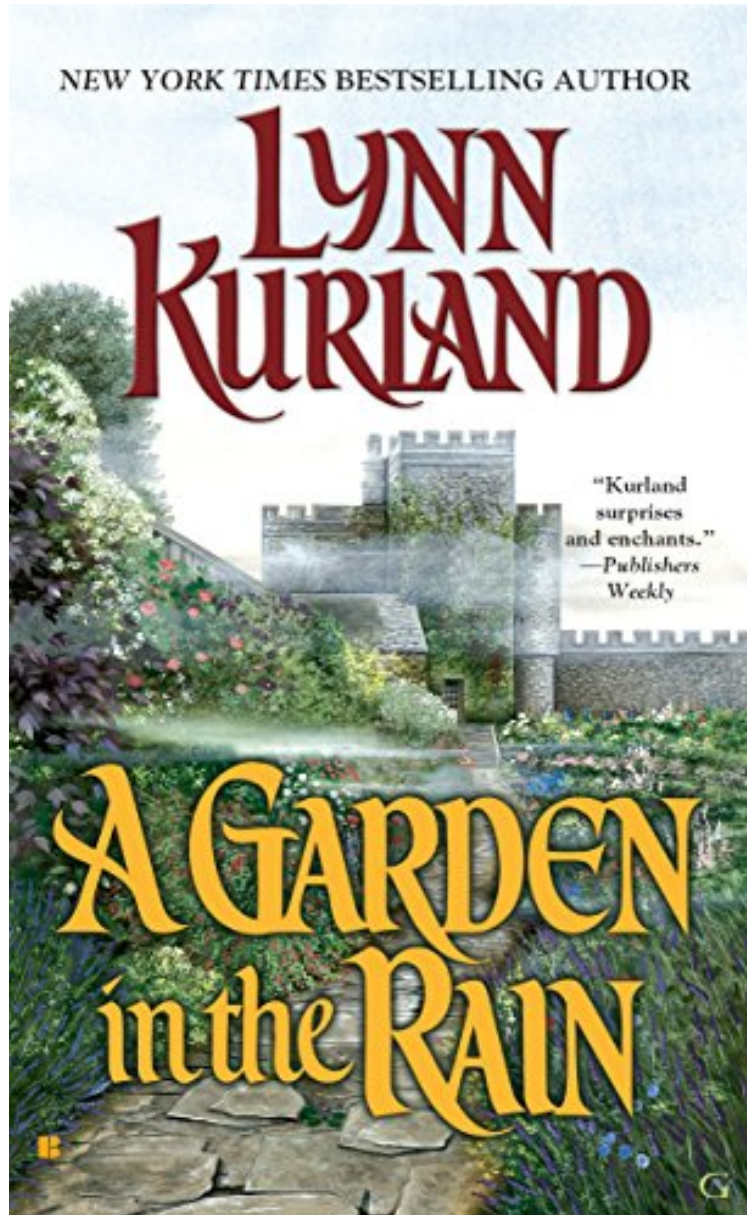

novels of her two families. But this one has been a bit of a disappointment. First: The heroine, Madelyn, suffers most of the novel in silence and is just a bit too stoic. I like my heroines more determined and fun-loving. Madelyn gets dumped some weeks before her wedding from her fiancée. Then she decides to go to Scotland on her own (her honeymoon) and to enjoy the weeks there, although she lost her job along with her husband-to-be, her flat and everything she always wanted.
