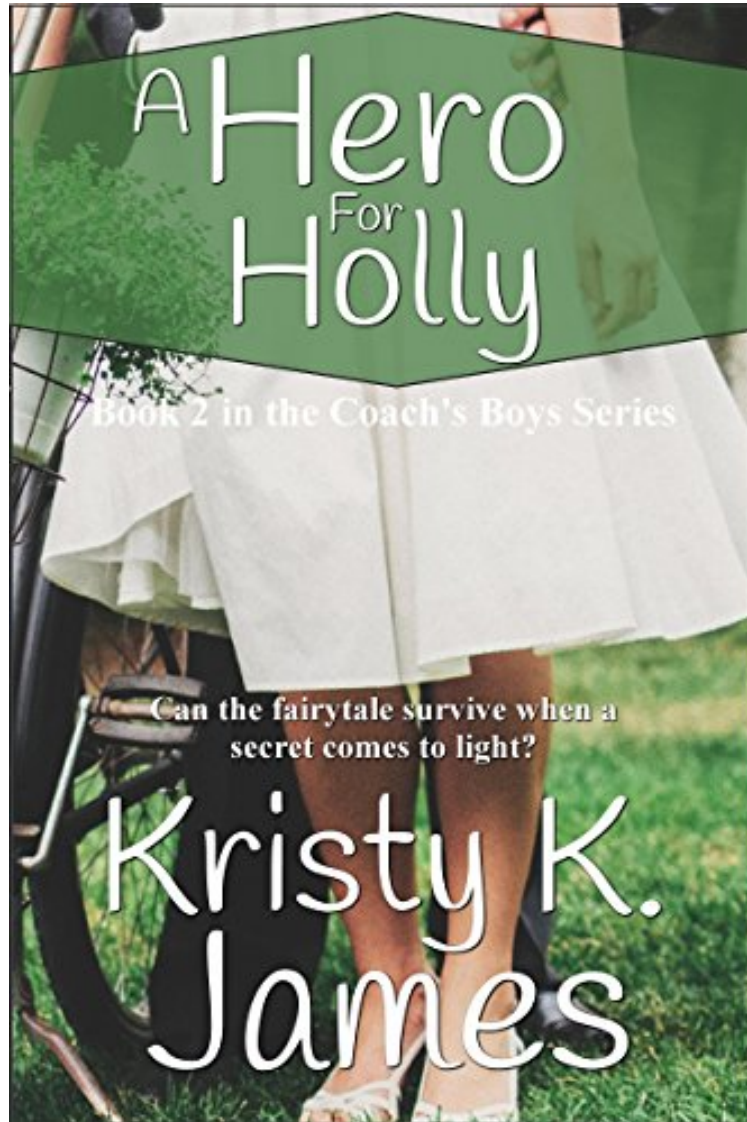

The whole story is told in a sort of very naive way and language and meanders along quite nicely. Except for the (obligatory?) villain in this story, everyone is nice to each other and helpful - a very idealistic view of the world. All in all, don't expect a gripping, fast paced romance story which you cannot put aside, but one that processes along nicely, with no surprises and very clear good vs evil characters. Still, a nice easy read if you don't have anything else more promising.
