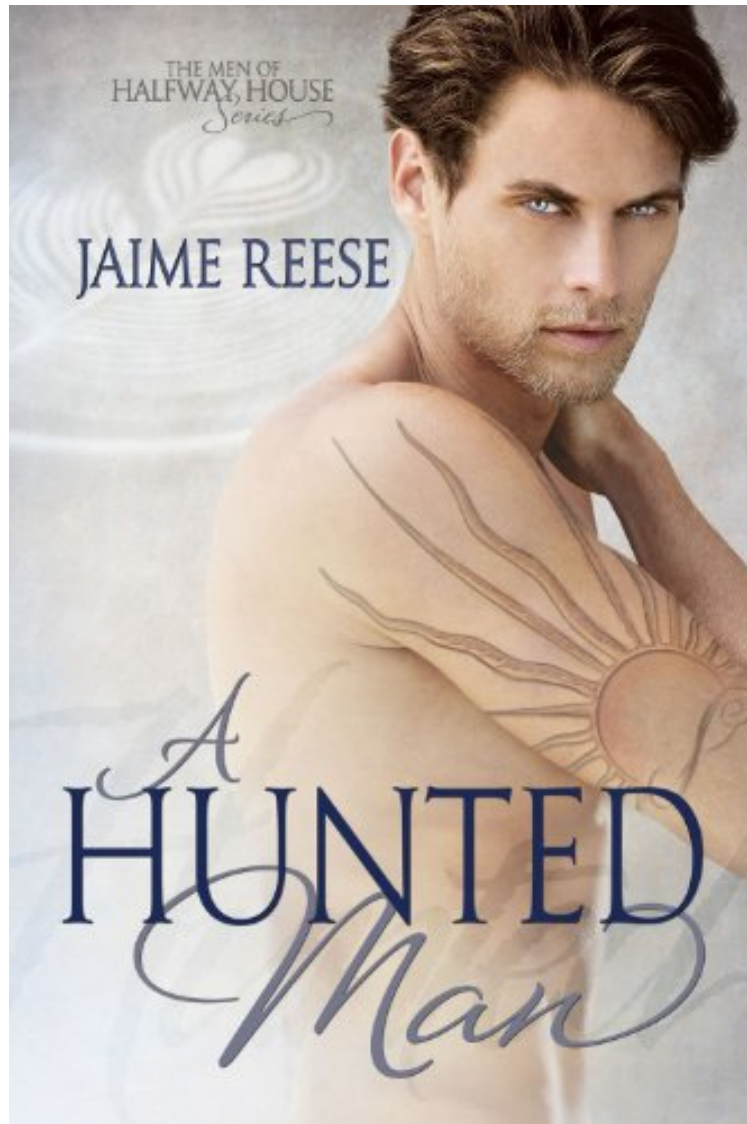

Series has been on my Kindle for quite some time and I am catching myself re-reading the books again and again when looking for an entertaining, fluent story with a gripping plot and likeable MCs. Guess, my reviews are now more than overdue. The first house guest of Halfway House arrives and boy, he has got a lot on his plate. Cam is one of those poor souls, who had been at the wrong place at the wrong time with nearly life devastating results. Somehow he has survived 10 years of prison time and desperately tries now to find a way back to an almost normal life. Falling fast and deep in love with the handsome customer at his new job had not been planned at all. To make matters even more interesting Hunter is working as assistant state attorney and discovers that something rather sinister is going on with Cam dead in the center of it. The reader follows breathlessly those two awesome MCs and shares their bad gut feeling, that this all can't end well. While the pace of book 01 had been mostly sedate, now in book 02 the drama accelerates from the start of Cam's release from prison, moving in to Matt Julian's and ends in a big shoot out showdown at Hunter's home. This time the plot is quite multilayered revealing a long planned, wide-range crime ring of drugscorruption with an unexpected ringleader. Cam Hunter can be lucky that Hunter's best friend and old Military buddy Aiden now works as a detective and is deep into the surveillance and digging to prove Cam's innocence. Still the happy end is a bit unsatisfying for me because our MCs get into the witness protection program. Fitted with new identities they move away from the main spot of Halfway House and leave their friends behind. Instead it's one half-assed dialogue between the soon-to-be couple after another, always combined with a bit or even more kissing in the cafe with its clients or sometimes in the backroom. But after the beginning it is fantastic! And really nice that there's no hastily constructed HEA, but a logical development to coupledness and happiness.
