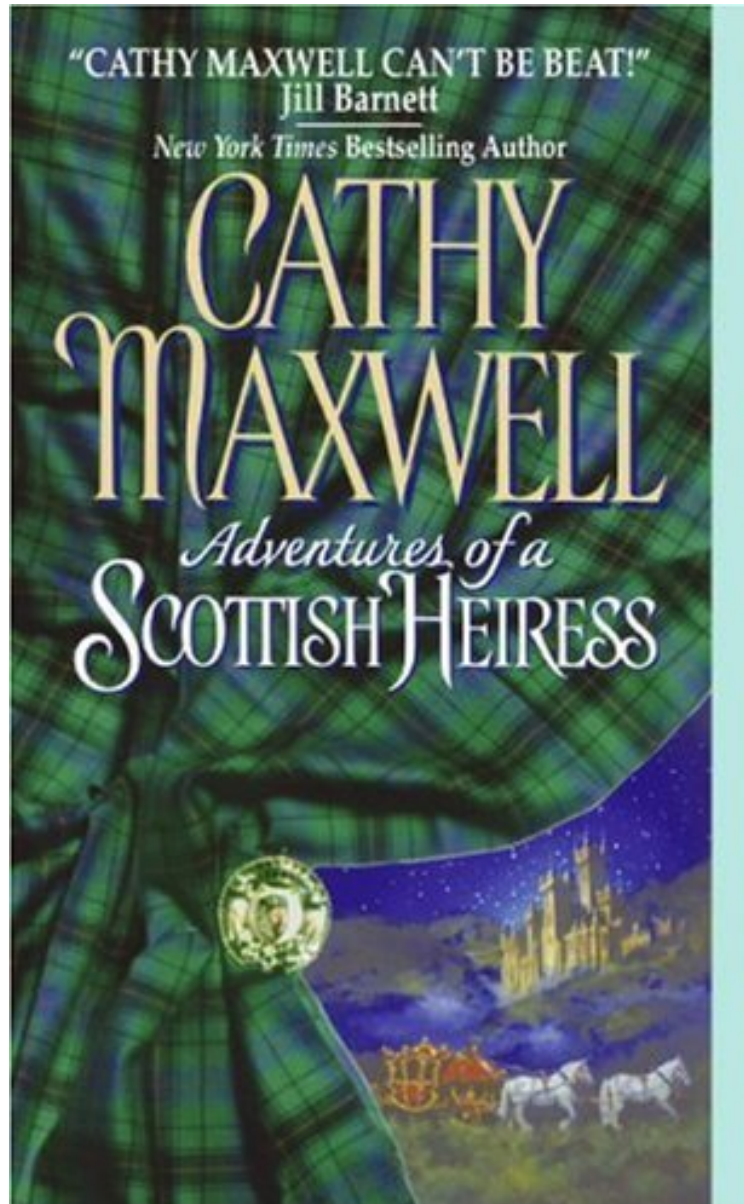

The two things that I loved most especially about it was that, first, the hero of this story is a 'normal' citizen. No duke or earl whatsoever. One with 'normal' problems in life. And second is that there is no kissing or bedding until it almost reaches page 300. But the sexual tension and passion is consistently present, but concealed.
