patient, his father urges him on to go the country for a while. There he meets Ava, who is an introverted, broken young widow. Their paths cross and they feel themselves getting entangled not just in a physical attraction, but in a complex, deep and troubled relationship. Both main characters have a back story that nearly drove me to tears, Ava's even more so. The story behind her husband's death is described at the beginning and it's not unnecessarily drawn out, but still, it was so heart-wrenching that I could really feel myself being at the edge of tears. Their story developed in a natural way, the pace wasn't too rushed or too dragging, so that I read it rather fluently. What I especially liked was the fact that it wasn't as dark and angsty as many New-Adult-Novels turn out to be. No, despite the fact that both characters were traumatized and had rough patches in their lives, Rene Carlino still was able to pull off beautiful, tender, sweet and funny scenes. I loved that the secondary characters weren't only there as decoration or plot devices if needed, but they were as real as Nate and Ava. The dynamics between Nate and his father were described beautifully and fitting for a special relationship like that. The story wrapped up easily and I loved the end, or rather the last part. The letters were heart-warming and cute, and again the end was realistic and believable, not overly dramatic.
