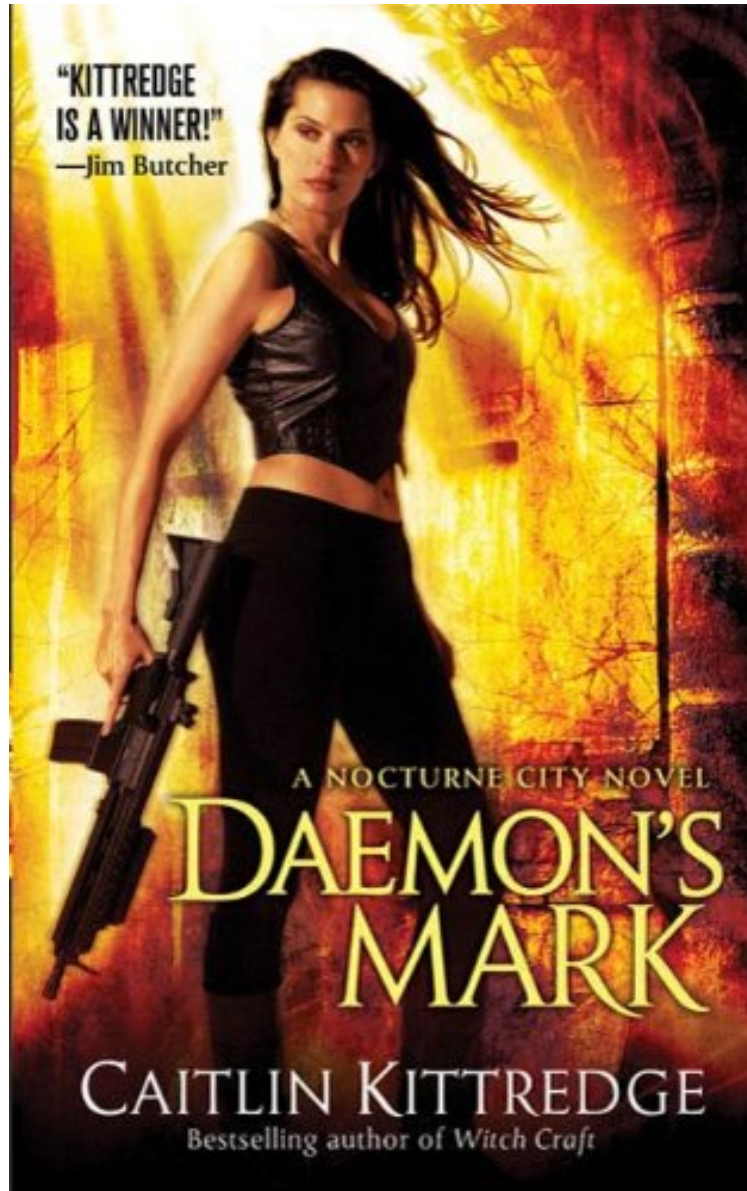

spannendes Buch, das Spass macht. Die Handlung ist rasant, die Dialoge sind gut und der Band schließt sehr schön an die Vorgänger in der "Nocturne City" Serie an. Der Grund, warum ich trotzdem nur drei Sterne vergeben ist, dass die Konstruktion diverse Schwächen aufweist. Nebencharaktere fallen gegen Ende aus dem Text, die Heldin macht Fehler, die bei ihrer Berufserfahrung einfach nicht vorkommen dürften (aber notwendig sind, damit die Handlung weiter geht...) und manche Vorgänge werden nicht genügend erklärt und bleiben schwammig. Kittredges "Nocturne City" Bücher hatten schon immer kleinere Probleme mit Logik und Plausibilität, was aber bei einer Erstlingsserie vorkommen kann. Ihre späteren Bücher ("Black London" Serie) sind allerdings sehr viel sorgfältiger konstruiert und geschrieben, daher erscheint der Kontrast zu "Daemon's Mark" umso auffälliger. Vielleicht liegt es daran, dass Kittredge inzwischen mehr auf andere Projekte fokussiert (in ihrem Blog schrieb sie, dass "Daemon's Mark" das letzte in der "Nocturne City" Reihe sein wird), auf jeden Fall macht dieses Buch den Eindruck, als ob es eine Bearbeitung durch Lektor und Autorin mehr hätte übertragen können. Für Fans von Luna Wilder und Co. ist "Daemon's Mark" auf jeden Fall zu empfehlen, es sollte nur gesagt werden, dass es deutlich schwächer ist, als Caitlin Kittredges andere Bücher. Luna Wilder, a werewolf detective, has to investigate the brutal murder of a teenage girl, which is connected both to the were community and the Russian mob. Soon she is threatened by both and ends up being kidnapped and smuggled out of the country by a mobster who uses weres and witches in the sex trade and worse. While trying to fight her way out of a seemingly hopeless situation, Luna encounters her former lover Dmitri again. He's still marked by the demon Asmodeus (part 1 of the series, Night Life), and neither he nor the demon have forgotten Luna... This novel is really intense and with a few exceptions, where I felt some events were a bit too coincidental (especially her meeting Dmitri by accident in an eastern brothel), it was pretty much perfect. Kittredge is definitely back to the shape she was in when she wrote the first two novels. I enjoyed this novel a lot and look forward to reading the next book in the series.
