The more he got to know Lisanne better, the more he felt at ease with her. Daniel was breaking his own rules by letting Lisanne into his quiet world and letting her get to know him. Daniel doesn't hide anything around Lisanne..The parentless house he lives in, the drugs his brother deals with. Daniel couldn't care less about all those things all he cares about is the girl who is interested in him and for what he really is- a normal guy. Not some cripple who can only lip read and not hear s\*\*\*I will stop right here with the story! All I can say is that I was sad, mad, no..cross mad. Impressed and left speechless Von Ling-Chang Before starting the actual review I'd like to first sum up the story a little: 19-year-old Lisanne Maclaine has just entered college with a major in music. To have something to fall back on if she fails in that business, she chose business courses too (It's actually her parents' wish). The first business class ("Introduction to business") she and her roommate attend they share the class with the very notorious "Daniel Colton", little brother to a drug dealer. Due to showing mostly no reaction when people try to talk to him he is considered rude - and because he is obviously dark, handsome and very mysterious also dangerous. When Lis and Danny are made to work together for an assignment even though both don't really enjoy each other's company, they are forced to get to know the other - which lets Lis know almost immediately the real reason to Daniel's behaviour and his best-kept secret. From here on out there might be a possibility of spoilers! This story starts off with a very typical setting (new beginning in a college, bullied goody-two-shoes girl, smug+dark+handsome+mysterious+rude+dangerous boy, 1st impression: don't exactly like but still attracted). All would be fine and the same as every book in this section ... but then ... surprise! During the work on the assignment for business class, Lis and Danny meet up in the library. Lis is angry with Danny and even though he asks her to, doesn't give up the seat with the back to the wall. At first he seems nervous but gets lost in the work. Then the fire alarm goes off and everybody leaves library - but Daniel shows no sign of having heard the alarm. That's when Lis notices: Daniel is deaf. (His hearing started getting worse when he was 14/15 at which point he was sent to a special school for disabled.) And from that point on both become fast friends and then lovers. But Daniel shows signs of still living in the past: His parents died 2 years ago and he misses them, he does not like to wear hearing aids (they don't help him as he's deaf and has not just difficulties hearing) because he feels people pity him and he just wants to be

normal, his brother is caught deep in the drug-dealer net but he is Daniel's only family, etc. Even though "disabled" Daniel has many other talents to boast: He has a part-scholarship (so he's very smart), he can lip-read almost faultlessly so he does not need hearing aids and he is almost as good at football as the current quarterback for the college football team. But he tries to avoid big crowds as he can only lip-read one person at a time and will not notice when others are talking to him if he doesn't face them properly. That's why people always misunderstand him. Although he is very shy in showing how he really feels missing his hearing sense and how he really always enjoys company Lisanne soon helps him reenter the world he felt bereft of - contrary to her friend's warning they even become a couple. Enough of the story. I give this book 5 stars! 1) What I really enjoyed is there were almost no faults in grammar and spelling - and when somebody like me notices that (English is NOT my mothertongue) it can safely be assumed there are only very few. So the reader can read very fluently without being shoved out of the story by seeing those mistakes (which weren't even that noticeable). 2) It starts off as a very easy love story and becomes soon very heated - trust issues included. Even though Lisanne first wants to know why Daniel refuses the operation which could help him "hear" again and initially wants to convince him to get through with it, she's soon fully on Daniel's side and supports his decision. 3) The dialogues were amazingly cute and witty and they felt REAL. 4) The story is not overshadowed by sexy and lovey-dovey scenes (which usually is one huge point for putting me off as there's almost no story to speak about in most books ... \*sigh\*). 5) The characters are all well-made :D They are distinguishable (if you know what I mean) and don't fade into the background. We have very strong main characters which is my absolute favorite "good point". 6) This story is no "10-minute-read". It can be read in 5 to 7 hours being totally immersed as I was. 7) You can identify. (I don't need to explain this. This is SO important.) I'd love to read more stories like this! God, if I hadn't already read it I would read it. I so recommend this book even though it does not make you cry - it touches you. I hope I could help and have fun reading it! I hardly ever read books about characters that are so young because I'm always afraid that they will be too childish and that the story will show a lack of depth. It was not the case with this one. I was very intrigued by the blurb and couldn't wait to see if the rest of the book will live up to it. I liked it very much that the author has addressed a very sensitive topic here - deafness and the daily struggles people with this impairment have to face. Lisanne Maclaine is a shy and very lovable young woman who is a music major at college. She is playing the violin and singing in a band. Lis is a responsible 19 year old who doesn't indulge in any excesses like other students around her. Being a seemingly plain girl she has zero experiences with boys. One day she sees the dark, sexy and dangerous looking Daniel Colton in one of her classes. He is well known on campus and rumors are following him everywhere. While working together on an assignment they get to know each other better. Daniel turns out to be very smart, funny and nice. By chance Lis discovers his biggest secret - Daniel is deaf. That's the reason why he is so closed off to everyone and keeping his distance. He doesn't want other people to know about his disability - he hates it when they pity him and treat him differently. Lisanne is deeply impressed by Daniel's way of coping with everything and accepts him the way he is. She encourages him to socialize with others. Daniel likes Lisanne's sassy side and the sexiness and self-confidence she oozes when she is onstage. He enjoys her company and appreciates her support. Their unusual friendship soon turns into something more. But can a deaf bad boy be a boyfriend to a girl next door whose love for music is such an important part of her life? Will Lis give Daniel a chance despite all the prejudices of her parents and other people? Will Daniel ever feel good enough for and worthy of Lisanne? You have to read this book to find it out! I loved Daniel and Lisanne as individuals and as a couple. They were very well-matched. He succeeded in showing her how beautiful she was from the inside and outside. She soothed him by giving him a place where he could be himself and where he didn't feel alone anymore. Both were mature for their age and their love for each other was deep and sincere. Sometimes their misunderstandings were very frustrating but they managed to learn how to tell one another their feelings instead of only showing them. I love a story with a tortured hero who is cured by the unconditional love of the heroine. Jane Harvey-Berrick did, as always, an amazing job here. This book taught me that in order to understand a person you don't only have to listen to her with your ears, you have to listen to her with your heart.
