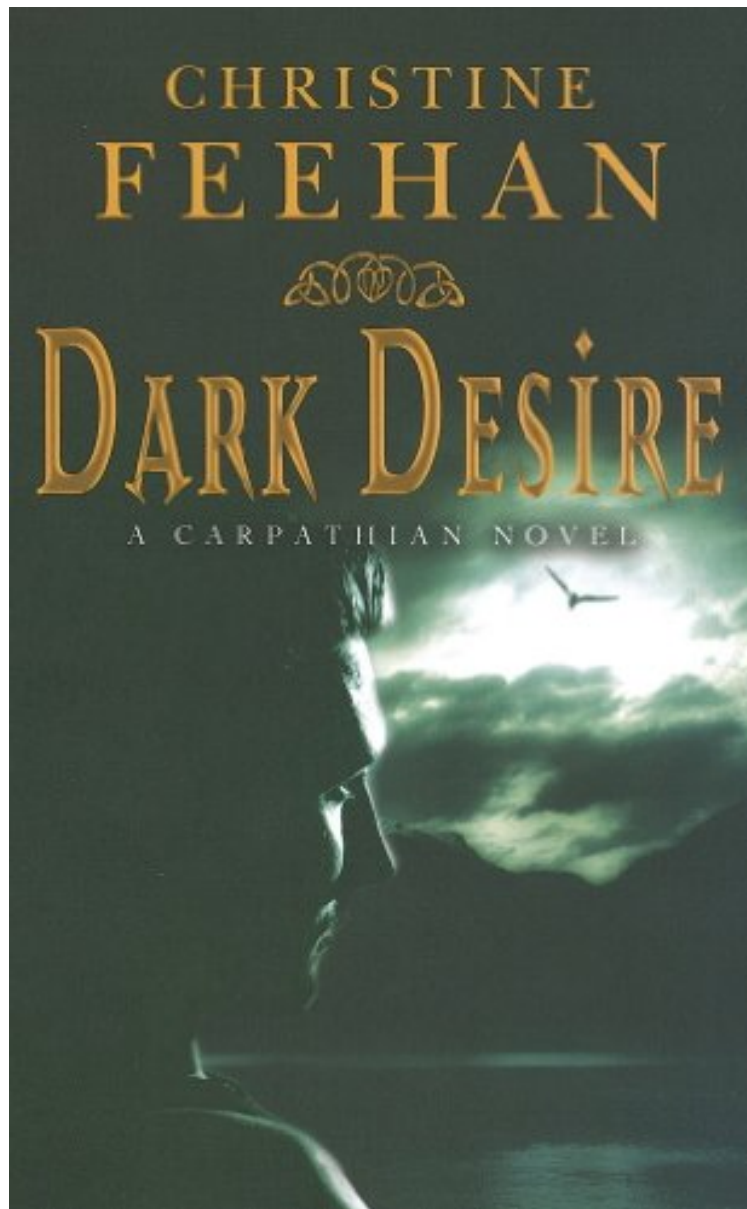

forwardVon Rin HayashiThat is the best way I can describe how this series progresses.In volume 1 we have met the first couple, Mikhail and Raven. Then we have nothing and now in volume 2 we have been - at the beginning - forwarded 18 years and then again 7 years. So a total of 25 years fast forwarded.As in volume 1 we have read that Mikhail uses a computer for work that is "really big", we have to assume it was the late 80's or early 90's. Fast forward and we are in the 2000's.One can only hope the series does not forward quite as quickly in the following volumes as this would make this love-story a sci-fi-story.At the beginning we meet Shea O'Halloran, a brilliant doctor. She is plagued by what she thinks are nightmares but are in fact Carpathian communication-attempts. When she follows them, she ends up helping the Carpathians, in particular Jacques, who turns out to be the one for her.One problem: Raven, the protagonist from volume 1, is said to be only 25 years old. In this book Jacques, brother of Mikhail Dubrinsky (Dark Prince) gets caught by a a vampire and some human fanatics. He is drugged, tortured and buried alive afterwards. He can't reach his family and cause of his constantly pains (over 7 years) gets absolutly "crazy". What he does not know in the beginning, that he is somehow connected to Shea, a half human half Carpathian. She is living in America and works as a surgeon. Because she is not totally human, but half Carathian, she needs blood. She believes in the beginning, that she has just a strange blood-disorder.:-). One day she gets connected to Jacques, just in the moment, the human fanatic vampire hunters are trying to destroy him with a wooden stake in his heart. They miss it by centimeters and Jacques stays "alive", with horrible wounds. The only thing which keeps him alive is his bound to Shea. In the beginning he thinks that she is one of his tormentors, but he also can see colours and has feelings again - is she his lifemate who abandoned him??He "forces" her with his will to look for him and rescue him....Shea always think she has bad dreams... but because she is hunted down by some vampire-hunters, she decides to flee into the carpathian mountains. She "HAS TO GO" to the cave were Jacques is caged. She resques him, although he is hurting her very badly when she gets into the cave, bur she is a doctor, that's why she has to "rescues" him. During the time she takes care for him, he tries to regain his memories and makes certain that Shea will never leave him again. Unintentional he converts her to a Carpathian woman, but Shea is not happy with that. She loves Jacques, even when he gets very dangerous sometimes, but ... she does not want to get adicted to him... fell in love with him. She is also repulsed by taking blood for nourishment. Her mother once loved a Carpathian and when he had to go deep into the ground to sleep for some reason (where she could not reach him), she thought him dead and mentally died too. She did not take care of Shea very well and when Shea got 18 she killed herself. Shea NEVER wanted to feel so much for a man!! But now... the feelings for Jacques.... it scares the hell out of her...Mikhail, Raven, Byron and Gregori detect the two and try to make Jaques remember everything. They also have to destroy the vampire, who is one of them, but betrayer to the Carpathians.... Meanwhile Byron is get cought too....
