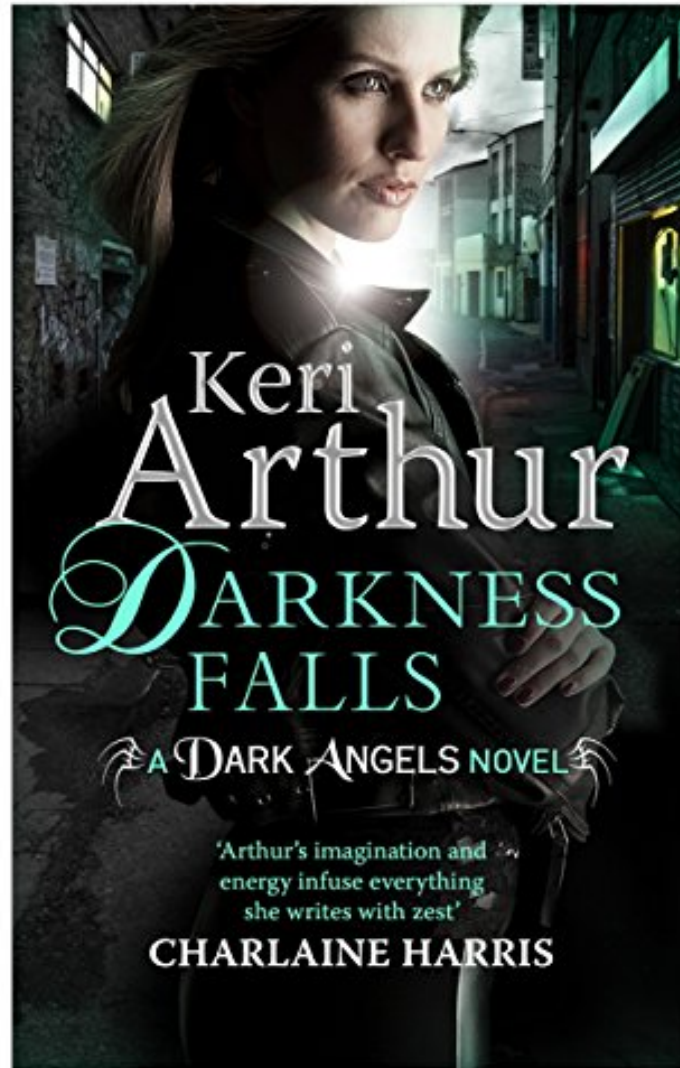

If you're new to it, I recommend to stop reading here and start with Darkness Unbound.ReviewFinishing the last book, I was wondering how Keri Arthur would manage to wrap up all loose ends in just one more book. And the answer to that is: she manages just fabulously. This is the best

installment in the series, a breathtaking mixture of following clues, unveiling deep reaching treachery and Hollywood worthy fighting scenes. I have to say that the three [!!!] pivotal showdowns Risa has to fight with or without Azriel's help were so satisfying, I found myself shouting out loud in glee [and am still asking myself what these murderous tendencies say about me...]. Right from the beginning, there is no moment to take any kind of break for Risa and Azriel, since all of her foes have upped the ante and there is no more restraint. And the cool thing for me is the fact that there isn't much restraint in Risa as well. She is forced to prevent her loved ones from being used against her or rather to blackmail her to search and give over the final key. At the same time, the Raziq decided she should again be re-made and this time in a more compliant form and there is still the question of the black sorceress and her male counterpart. Is she banned to hell forever or will she come back? Was she male and female or is there a second sorcerer hunting them to get the key? For me this thread had taken a bit of a back seat with Hunter getting off the deep end, Lucian dead and the sorceress in hell and I was in no way prepared for how it all played out. That was ingenious! And although there were hints that something was wrong in that regard in Darkness Splintered, I had no idea it was that wrong. And when Risa finally decides that it's enough with the threats and the getting used and the overall doom hanging above her head, she rises to the challenge and that was fun to read. Boy, is she fed up! I really cannot say more without spoiling too much of the fun, but I can tell you that really each and every part of the plot is wrapped up nicely and Risa now has earned her place in my Top Ten UF Heroines, since she acts like a grown up, does what is necessary and actually thinks before battling away. And battling she does, oh boy! This is a satisfying end to the overall good series that I enjoyed a lot. If you like the series, you'll love this one.
