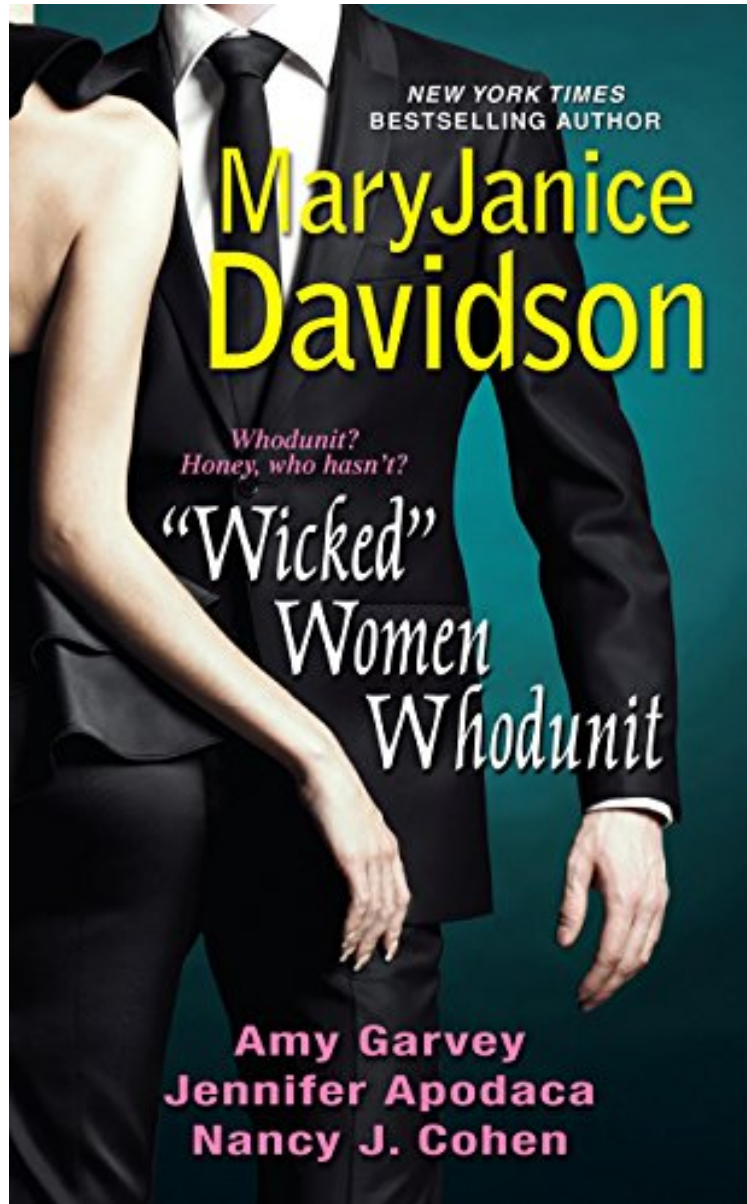

mixed bag, but with one really good story Von S. Fischer This is a collection of 4 novellas mixing romance and crime story. Apodaca's story is very good, the rest between average and pretty bad. MaryJanice Davidson: Ten little idiots Isolated by a storm at an island inn, several guests and employees are less than pleased when one of them confesses a murder, then locks herself in her room. Who was murdered and why? While they are trying to figure that out it becomes obvious that they are still in danger - but this doesn't stop Caro and Turner from feeling a strong sexual attraction for each other. This is the story most people will be interested in because Davidson is the best-known author in the bunch. It's not awful, but I wasn't too impressed either. Everything is very hurried, she's written funnier stories with a better plot. I'd say it's an average story and wouldn't recommend buying this book just for this. Amy Garvey: Single White Dead Guy Lanie Burke wants to spend the weekend in her friend's remote cabin, but ends up in a bar because she can't manage the strong snowfall with her city car. She then spends the night with the hot man she picked up at the bar. In the morning, there's a dead man on her doorstep and she spends the day investigating the murder. This one's not bad, but I didn't feel entirely comfortable with the basic situation, i. e. meeting a complete stranger in a bar and going off to a lonely cabin with him. A real recipe for disaster that one. But the crime story wasn't bad and the main characters were likeable. Jennifer Apodaca: Fast Boys Psychiatrist Tess Collins has a problem: Since she met Ark Underwood as a young girl once, she's been secretly in love with him, but nothing ever came of it. It's unlikely to, since by now he is a famous racecar driver, so what chances does a normal woman have? When her friends insist that she cure herself by writing down all the possible weaknesses Ark might have, the list falls into the hands of a tabloid reporter. When she tries to stop him from exploiting this list, she ends up meeting Ark at last - but when the reporter turns up dead in Ark's room, the two are in quite a bit of trouble. Can their mutual attraction lead to something more under these circumstances? This story was the high-point of the collection with an intelligent crime plot, well-developed characters and being believable. I liked it a lot. Nancy J. Cohen: Three men and a body A reality show brings several contestants together at a lonely inn. The task is to work together to open a bed and breakfast. The winner will get the inn after the end of the show. But very soon there's a murder, then several suspicious accidents. Heather Payne, one of the contestants, is very attracted to another participant, Rex Gerard. But can she trust him or is he the killer? The story was not very convincing (only one of the contestants actually has any interest in having an inn, the rest want a ship, a beauty salon etc.), and to make it worse, the characters are mostly clichéd and the writing is often absolutely awful. Especially when it comes to erotic scenes, Cohen breaks out in purple prose of the worst kind. I had a hard time finishing this. To summarise: Apodaca's story is excellent, Garvey's and Davidson's are not bad but nothing special either, Cohen is not good at all. There are better anthologies out there, so this one is only worth it if you are interested enough in one of the authors to spend the money for them alone.
