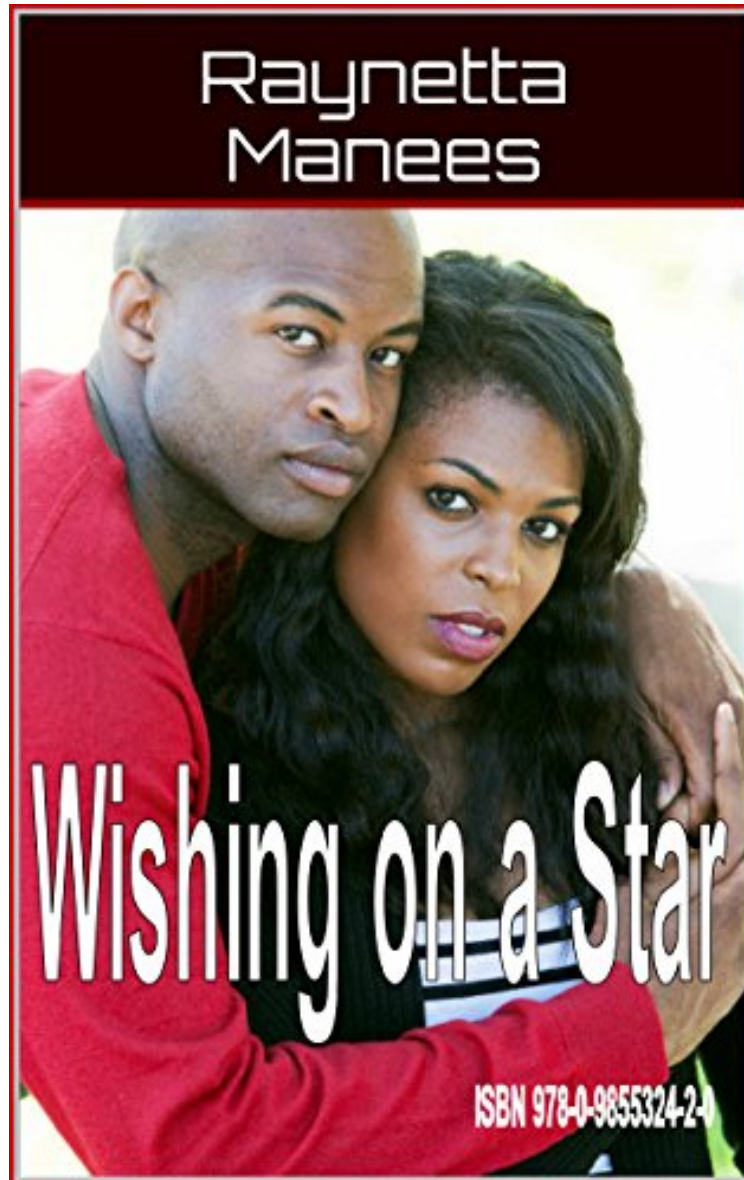

reading *Wishing on a Star* I realized why it had been in a box for two years. I must say this book was a disappointment. More time was spent on Shay and Ric's relationship than on Shay and Wood's (I would say 80% of it was spent on Shay and Ric's relationship). I can only speak for myself, but when I read a romance novel, I like reading about the two people who are going to end up together. This story also disappointed me in the fact that it was unrealistic. Lets get real, how many men (especially African American) men would pine over a woman who is having sexual relations with another man? Woman can handle a man being with another woman better than a woman being with another man (in my own opinion). The thought of someone like Wood behaving like a whopped bafoon was too much for me stomach. Next, Shay's character was a disgrace (and pitiful).
