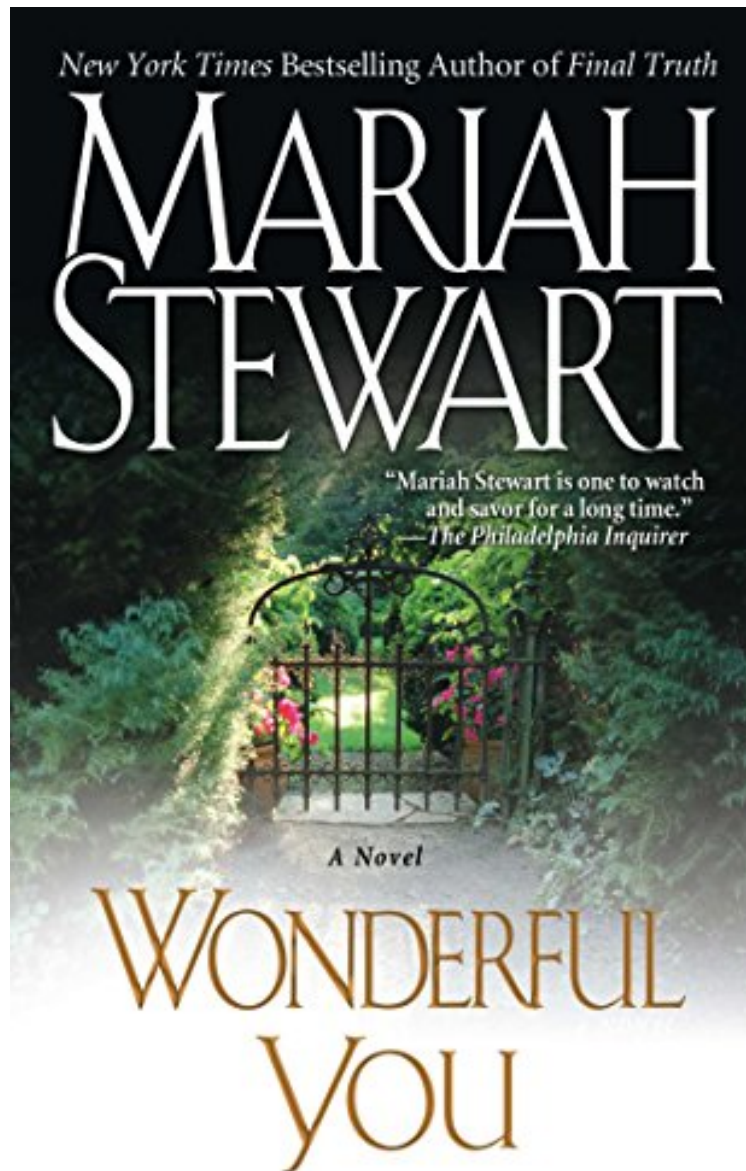

I hadn't read Devlin's Light (which I didn't need to since it was pretty much summed up in this story), and Wonderful You stands fine on its own (though it is very obvious that there was a predecessor and will be a sequel - or two). There were definitely some great points in this book - like who couldn't love a mother who keeps Godiva chocolates in her glove compartment? But on the whole, there was nothing in here that made me say "wow". The characters, while likable, are not very deep. I felt kind of cheated. This is obviously a close family who love one another a lot, but that is the only emotion I got out of them. It seemed to border on superficiality.
