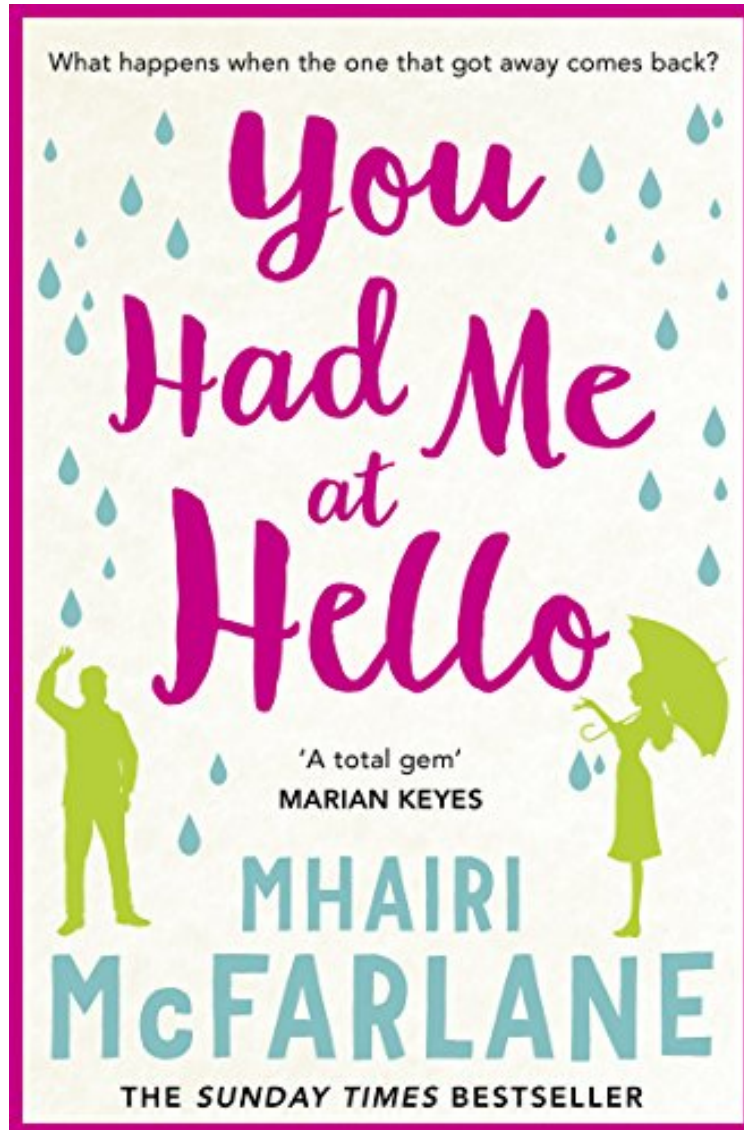

Guessing that usually the follow-up never meets the level of the tribute novel, I had high hopes.The book was fine enough, but I'm not sure I like the main character. She's hardly taking any action and her life mainly consists of prodding along with bad decisions made for her, hurting lots of people in the

process of doing so. In combination with actually making some really dumb decisions the book quickly becomes a series of "oh no..."s and "come on, say it!/ do it!"s. The end is too short for my taste and I got the impression that the book was going on and on and the author in the end didn't know how to turn the events around and thus wrote a highly unlikely end that suddenly changes everything. I also don't really like that the chapters jump in time between their college time and present; I guess there's no better way to give the reader a feeling for their university days, but it makes it a bit hard to get really involved in the story. What I love about McFarlane is that the main characters in this and her other novel are smart and successful and don't need a guy to rescue them. It's a refreshing change from what feels like 90% of chick lit. For all my criticism, I'd definitely recommend this novel.
